TRAVEL, BACKLINE AND HOSPITALITY RIDER

Travel- Should travel be 300 miles or greater, the promoter, agent or venue shall provide five rooms and meals. If travel is by air the promoter, agent or venue shall provide airfare for 5, as well as 1 night hotel stay and 1 meal per engagement day.

Backline- If ground travel is agreed, band will provide backline. However, if air travel is necessary, promoter, agent or venue shall provide the following backline equipment:

- LEAD VOCALIST- wireless Shure or Sennheiser microphone and in ear monitor.
- LEAD GUITARIST- Marshall, Vox, EVH 100W minimum guitar amp (stack or combo, must include effect loop- to be validated by band)
- BASS PLAYER- 450-watt minimum head with 4x10 cabinet or Ampeg 450-watt minimum head with 4x10 cabinet or equivalent (to be validated by band)
- KEYBOARD PLAYER- Nord Stage 2, Yamaha Montage or MODX also two-tier stand, two sustain pedals and a volume pedal – or equivalent (to be validated by band)
- DRUMMER- Drum kit with two rack, two floor and two kick drums, two crashes, hi hats and a ride. Drummer will provide his own pedal(s).

Hospitality - Promoter, agent or venue shall provide a 'green room' for the band, plus one case of bottled water. If alcohol is provided at the venue, then two drinks per band member is suggested.

The above requirements are subject to change and can be discussed at any time prior to the engagement.
